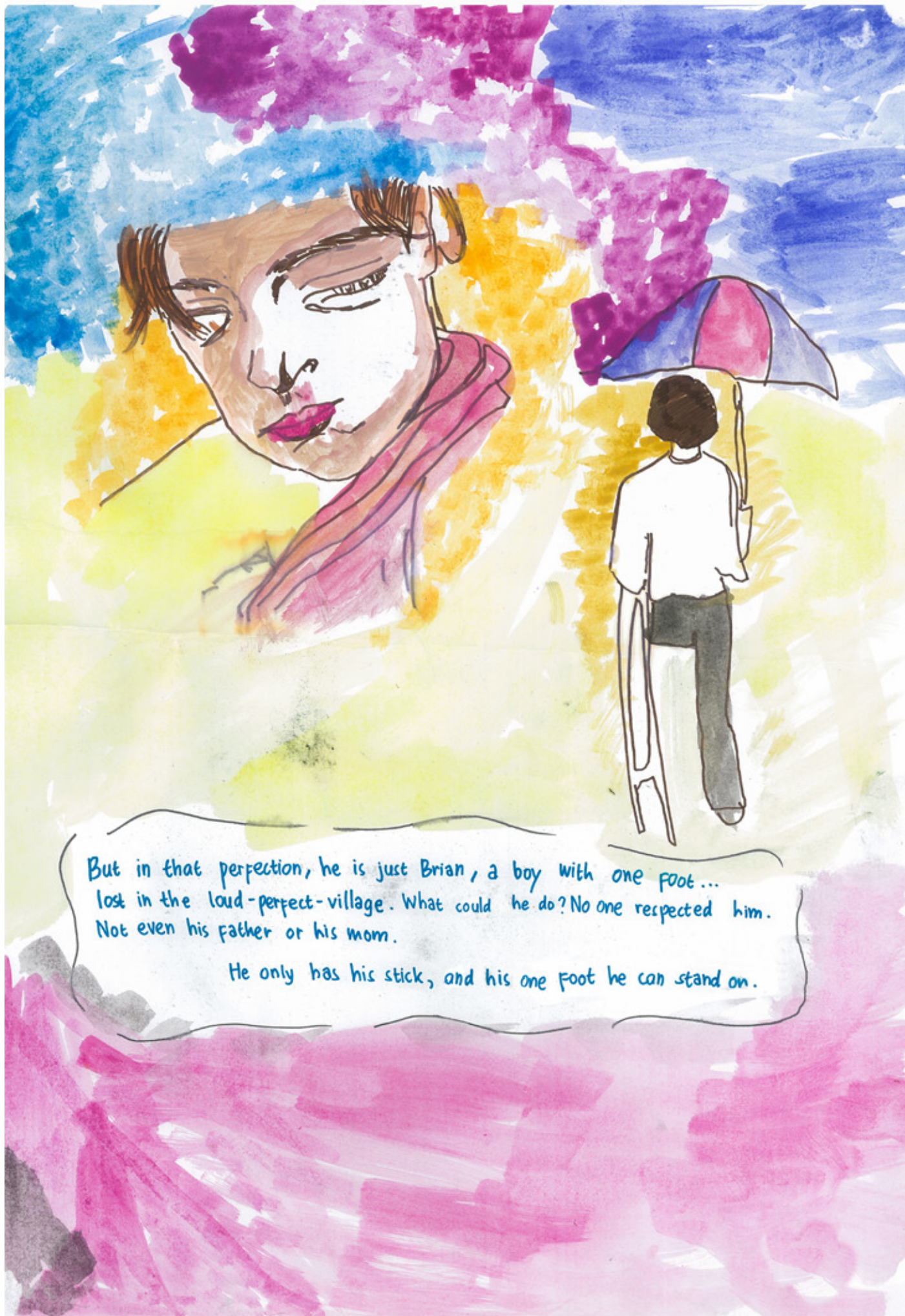
The Flawless DANCER

looked at him.

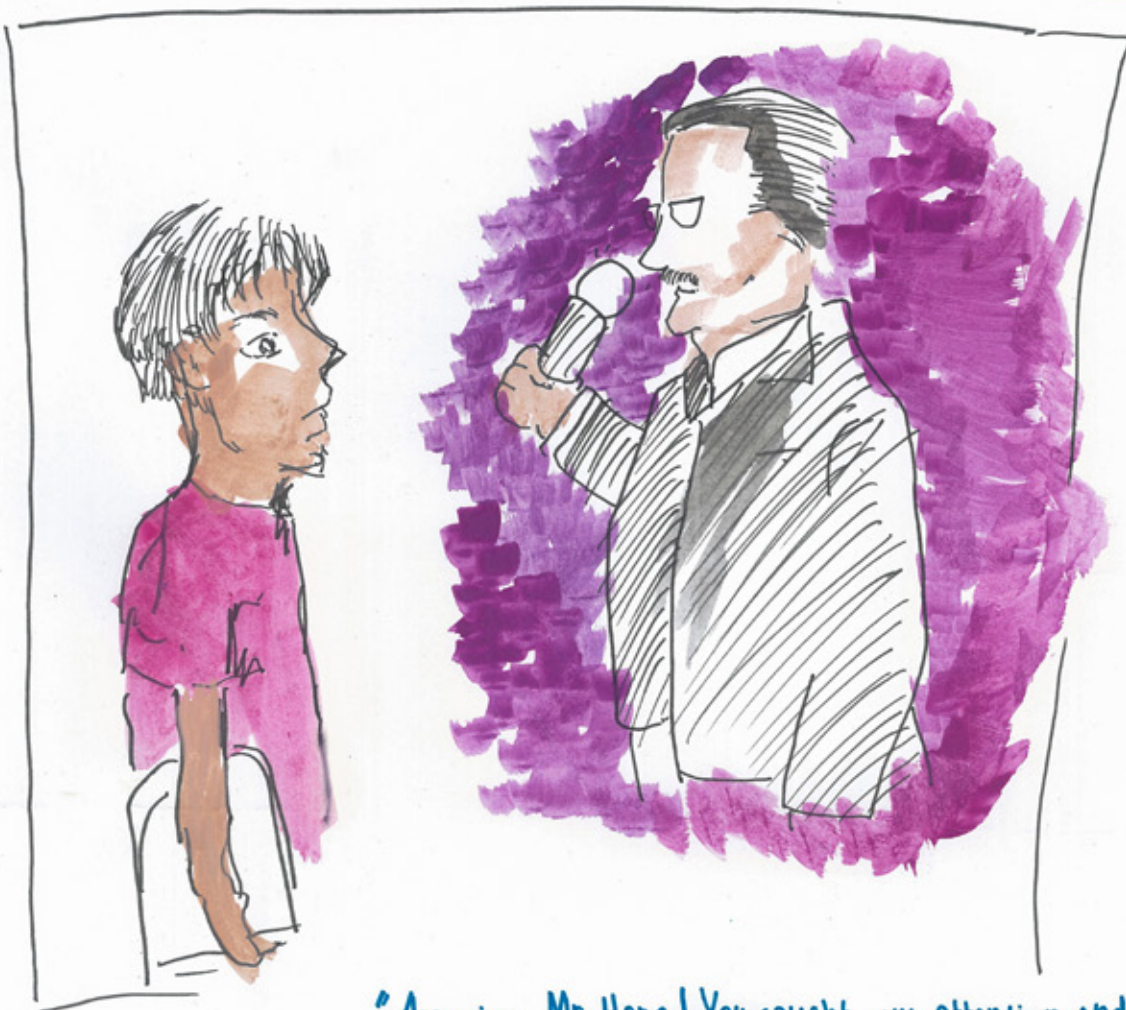
"I'm not perfect and that's okay,"
