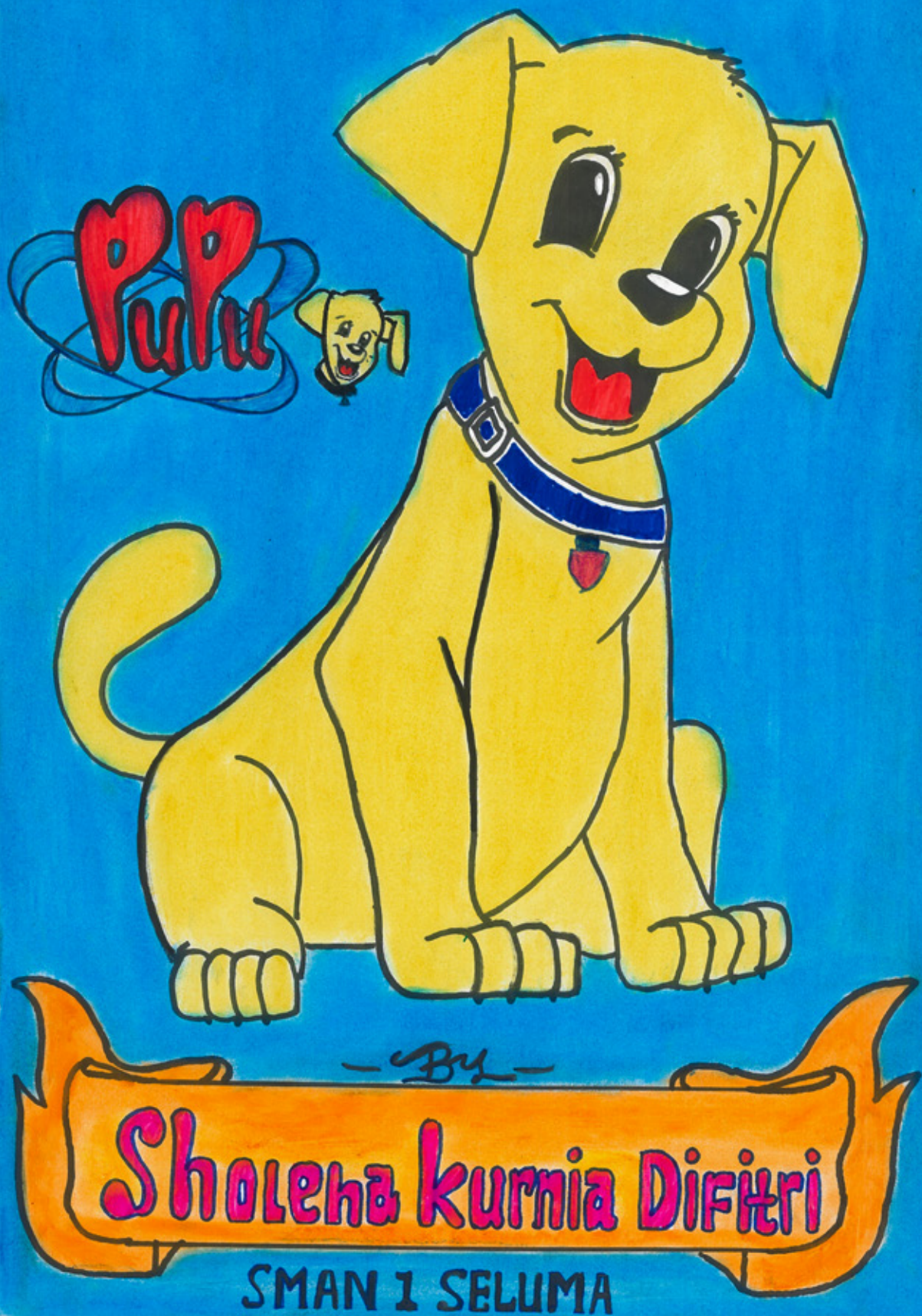

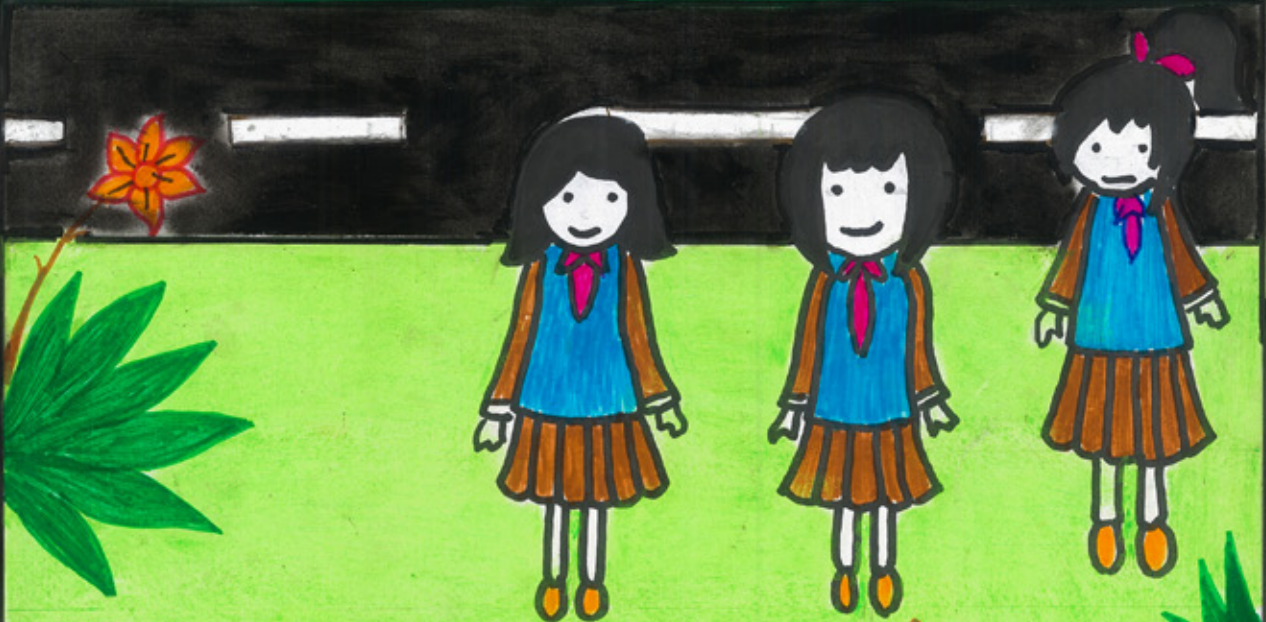
SMAN 1 SELUMA

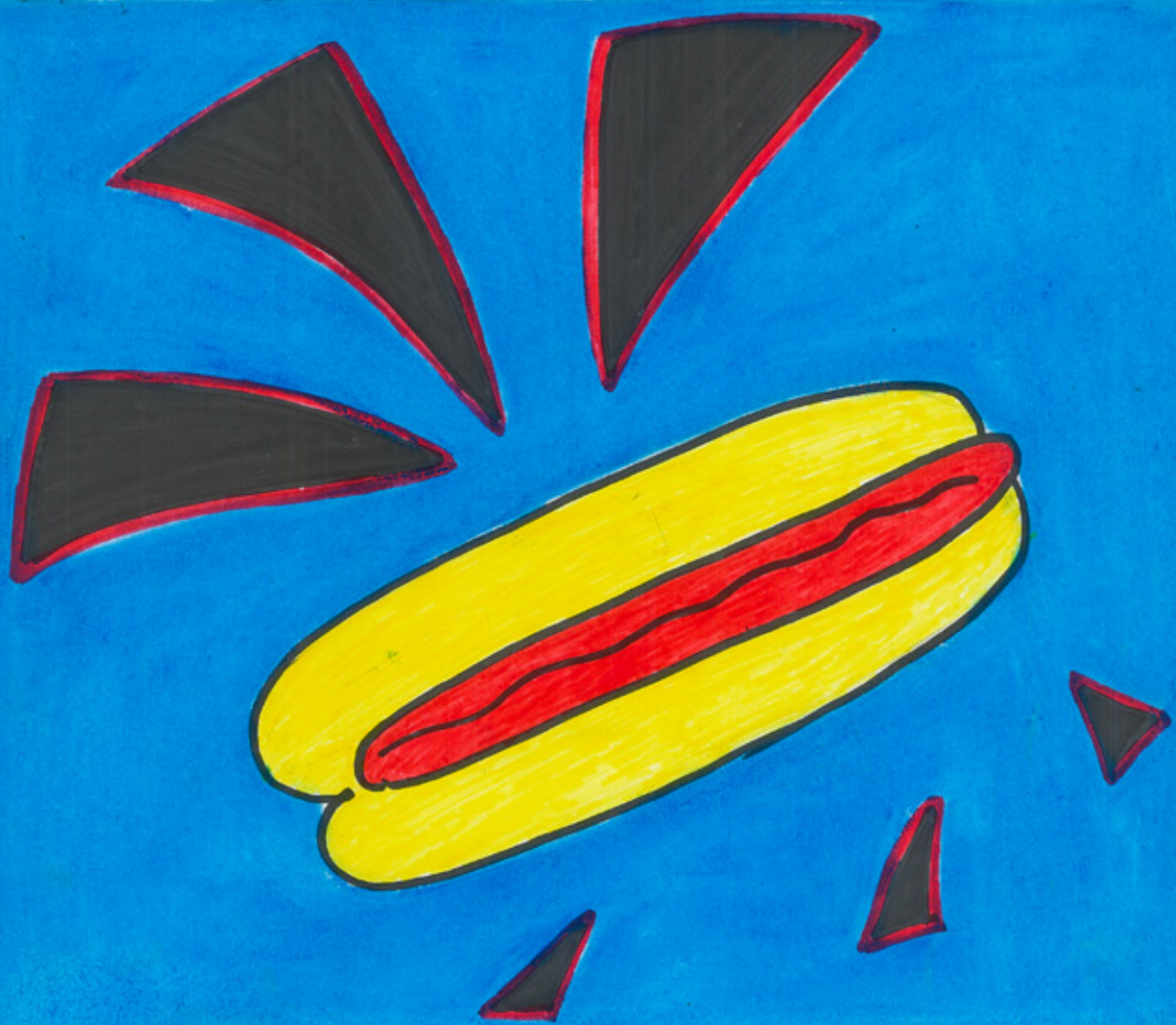
PUPU was a very good doggy .

and wait .





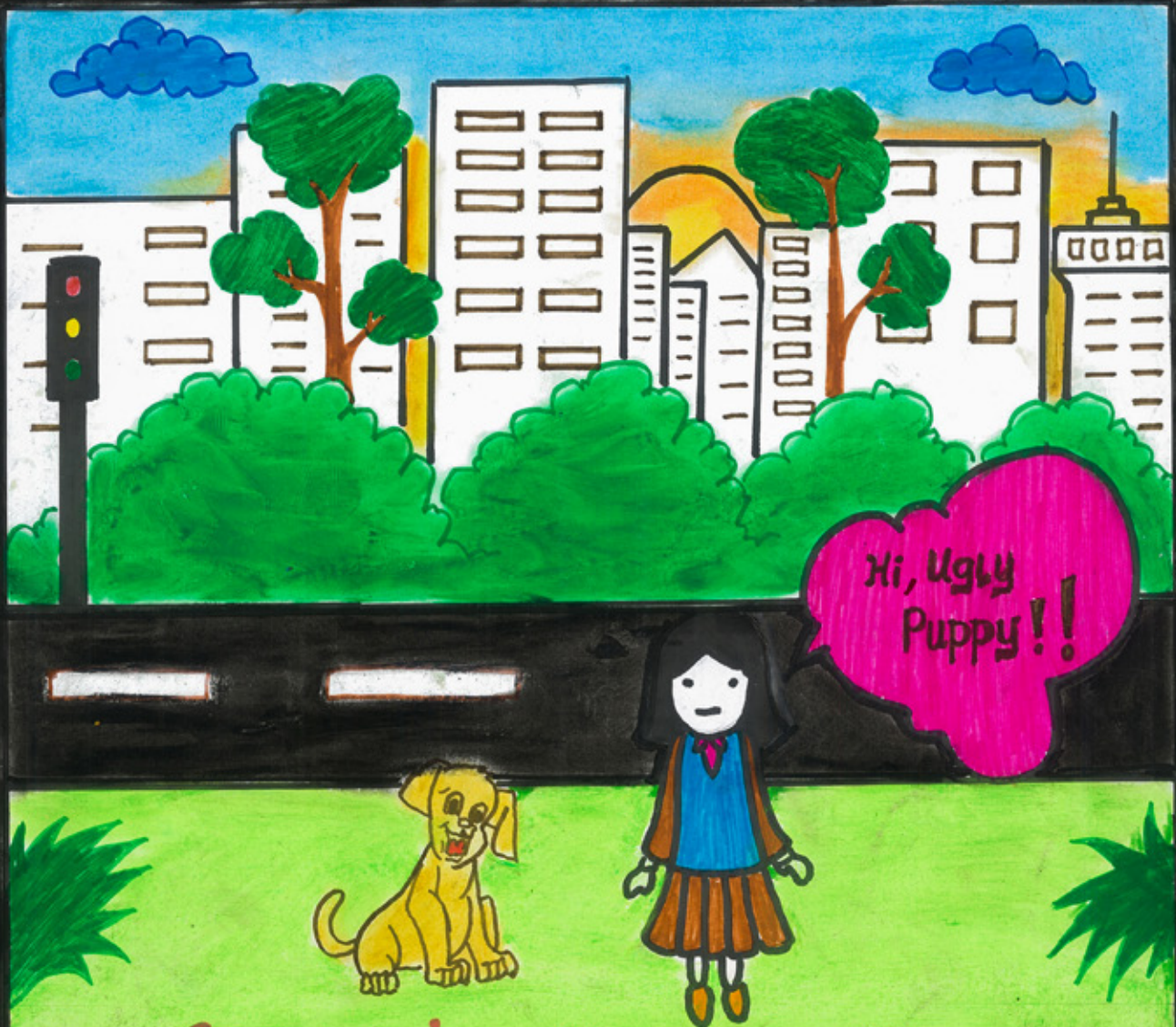
Pupu was a small puppy, but he had a scary face. There was a child who didn't like him, her name was Ayen. Ayen often mocked and refused Pupu's help.

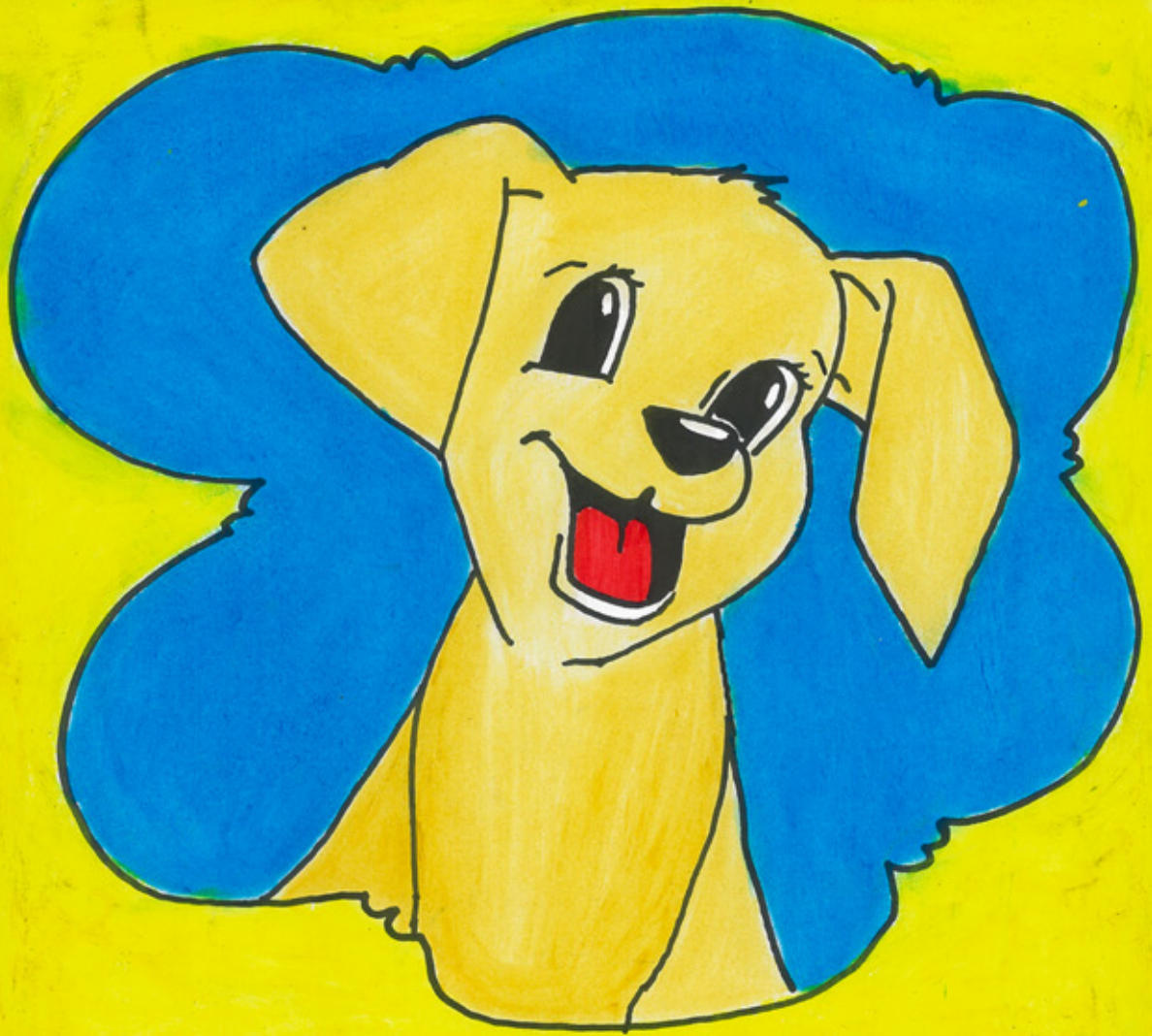
