

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

East Asia & Pacific



Host Institution: University of Bangka Belitung

Host Country: Indonesia

Project Activities: The Fulbright Specialist **conducted workshops and seminars on American culture, literature, and pedagogy** at three Indonesian universities. In addition to sharing American literary perspectives, the Specialist **shared scholarly and pedagogical resources** to support faculty research, academic writing and analysis, and creative writing.



Host Institution: Epic Arts

Host Country: Cambodia

Project Activities: The Specialist worked with the host, an arts NGO that facilitates community outreach and social enterprise programs for people with disabilities, to **develop a comprehensive fundraising plan** and identify strategies for a new fundraising committee. The Specialist also led a **multi-day workshop on developing a unified “brand voice”** for the organization.



Education

Host Institution: Ministry of Education Funafuti

Host Country: Tuvalu

Project Activities: As part of the host's effort to address poor scores on the Pacific Secondary School Certificate (PSSC) test, the Specialist **assessed instructional gaps in science education** through PSSC data analysis and classroom observation. The Specialist then delivered a **report with recommended improvements to curriculum and science educator training** at a national level.



Host Institution: University of Auckland

Host Country: New Zealand

Project Activities: The Specialist enhanced coastal engineering lab facilities by advising on research relevance, suggesting experimental improvements, and guiding the utilization of resources for practical applications and future projects.



Host Institution: Kaohsiung Medical University

Host Country: Taiwan

Project Activities: The Specialist supported **curriculum development for a proposed Doctoral Program in Nursing Practice**, led a **short course on Academic Writing and Manuscript Preparation** for faculty, and provided one-on-one advising to faculty and graduate students on their research manuscripts.
